YES! YOU CAN CARRY!

- 👍 Hospitals & similar medical facilities
- 👍 Public areas (except prohibited areas)
- 👍 Banks / financial institutions
- 👍 Places of worship
- 👍 Private property / businesses
- 👍 Driving past a school on a public street
- 👍 National Parks
- 👍 Grocery & liquor stores
- 👍 Public Transit
- 👍 Retail Stores (such as Target, clothing or grocery stores, malls or movie theaters)
- 👍 Native American Reservations

NO! YOU CAN'T CARRY!

- 👎 Amusement parks
- 👎 Zoos, museums, & libraries
- 👎 Athletic areas & facilities
- 👎 Bars & restaurants that serve alcohol
- 👎 Federal, state or city gov buildings - courthouses, city halls, elected official offices
- 👎 Casinos
- 👎 Schools, colleges, & universities
- 👎 Prisons & jails
- 👎 Stadiums & arenas
- 👎 Preschool or childcare facilities
- 👎 Nuclear sites
- 👎 Police, CHP, or sheriff stations
- 👎 ALL airport property (secure & unsecure areas)
- 👎 Military bases
